THE BIG IDEA

Jesus knows us.

THE BIBLE

Jesus Calls Philip and Nathanael:
John 1:43-51; (Psalm 139:1-6, 13-18)

QUESTIONS

- Who invited Nathanael to meet Jesus?
- What did Phillip tell Nathanael to do when he was suspicious about Jesus?
- Why was Nathanael amazed by Jesus?
- Read Psalm 139:2. What does this verse say about how much Jesus knows us?
- How does it make you feel knowing Jesus knows you so well?
- Can you trust God more now knowing that God knows so much about you?
- Phillip told Nathanael about Jesus. Who is someone you can tell about Jesus?

ACTIVITY

Give the kids a half-sheet of cardstock paper. On one side, have them draw a picture of themselves with their friend. Then draw a square box around the friend's face to "Tag" them, and write their name next to the box. Underneath the photo, have them write "Tag! You're Invited!" Then, write a message to them on the other side.

When you post a photo on certain social media sites, you can click on a person's face and "tag" them. When you tag them, you are inviting them to see the photo with you. You're telling them, "I like having you in the picture!"
