THE BIBLE

Jesus Helps a Suffering Man:
Mark 1:21-28; (Psalm 111)

QUESTIONS

- Why was the crowd amazed by Jesus' teachings?
- Who did the suffering man say that Jesus is?
- Did Jesus become more or less popular after this event?
- Read Mark 1:27-28. Why is it important that the message of Jesus spreads?
- What are ways we can help share the powerful message of Jesus?
- Are there ways to share the message of Jesus without talking?
- Who in your life does not know Jesus and needs to hear this message?

ACTIVITY

Assign one or more verses to each kid to illustrate. Then, put the illustrations together and read Psalm 111 aloud. Record it, upload it, and send a private link to the parents to view. You could even post it on your church social media pages, granted you have parental consent.
